6. The assessment data below includes all students with test results at the school and may differ from the School Performance Reports. The School Performance Reports do not count test results for students marked "Time in School less than one year" in NJSMART.
7. Due to differences in state assessment data in grades 3 to 8 and high school, the Academic Framework separates schools into two categories: Elementary School/Middle School and High School. Schools that have NJASK data in grades 3 to 8 will be evaluated using different metrics than schools that serve students in grades 9 through 12. If a school includes both of these grade spans, the school's grade spans will be evaluated separately. For example, if a school serves students in grades 6 through 12, grades 6 to 8 will be evaluated separately from grades 9 through 12. The NJDOE will produce two school cards for this school in this report.
